





Born in 1943, Shanghai, Yu Youhan graduated from Central Academy of Art and Design, Beijing, in 1973. One of the leading figures in the movement of China's avant-garde movement in the 90s, he is known for the aesthetic style of Political Pop and abstract painting, where he reinterprets classical Chinese philosophy and cultural traditions in modern and abstract artistic formats. Yu lives and works in Shanghai.

Yu has exhibited works extensively around world. He has participated in the 22nd São Paulo Art Biennial (1994) on behalf of the PRC, and the 45th Venice Biennale (1993). His ongoing retrospective exhibition *Trace: Yu Youhan*, is held at He Art Museum in Foshan, Guangdong from August to December 2022. The upcoming solo exhibition *Eternity and Ever-Changing* will take place at G Museum, Nanjing (24 September – 25 November 2022).

DAW Chinese Contemporary Art Collection: A Collector's Story

DAW was exposed to and fascinated by western contemporary art through attending Art Basel and working in New York in the late 1980s and early 1990s. He was collecting western Pop art, a reflection of the rising industrialisation and economic power in the 1960s and 1970s.

When visiting Shanghai and wider China for the first time in 1997, DAW quickly felt the shift from communism to capitalism and was introduced to Lorenz Helbing, a Swiss and owner of ShanghART Gallery. DAW was intrigued by the quantum shift in economic growth, infrastructural mega projects, and the fast social adoption by the Chinese people. This shift was reflected in the Chinese Contemporary Art driven by creative and free-spirited artists. DAW was immediately attracted by the strength and power of this art.

With the support of Lorenz, DAW visited most of the represented artists in their studios and started to collect works from many of China's most significant artists, including Zeng Fanzhi, Zhang Enli, Wang Guangyi, among many others..... Recently, PHILLIPS spoke with DAW about how he entered the art world and the evolution of his collecting journey.

PHILLIPS: How did your path to collecting Chinese Contemporary Art begin? Do you recall what the first piece was you acquired?

DAW: I took my time to visit many galleries and artist studios, before buying my first Chinese Contemporary Art pieces, since I wanted to deeply understand the market (I guess a very Swiss approach). Finally, I bought my first pieces from Xue Song, Geng Jianyi, Ding Yi and Zeng Fanzhi at once through ShanghART in 2002.

PHILLIPS: Looking back over your collecting journey, how have your tastes evolved?

DAW: When the Chinese Contemporary Art market started to take off through the first pieces appearing at auctions in 2006-2007 (for example, Zeng Fanzhi shot in the world auction ranking from position 4,968 in 2004 to 28 in 2007), a new and younger generation of artists emerged with different views and topics reflecting the quantum shift and the fast-changing world. I started to visit these younger artists and collecting their artworks.

PHILLIPS: You are truly an engaged collector in that many of your works have been purchased directly from the artists' studios. Is it important for you to meet artists in person?

DAW: I am a very curious person and like to meet interesting people. Therefore, it was natural for me to meet the source of inspiration and understanding more about the creators.

PHILLIPS: What is the focus regarding the artists in your collection? Do you feel there are themes that unites the works you have acquired? What inspires you in this category of art?

DAW: To simplify it, I guess that my collection is all about faces, scapes (land and city) and objects. It all goes back to the people, their country, and creations.

PHILLIPS: What advice would you give to a collector who is just starting out? What criteria should one set for oneself when collecting?

DAW: First of all, it is important to collect what you like (unless you see art as alternative investment asset). Second, I never saw myself as a collector, as I was passionate about living with the art pieces. Third, if you are buying into new art (like I did at that time) and it does not cost too much money (all relative of course), do not worry too much. If the price tag is heavier, carefully look at the artist works portfolio and evolution, understand the role of the gallery representing the artist and check out potential auction results.

PHILLIPS: Apart from art, are there any other interesting categories that you've collected in? Does this relate to your art collecting habits or philosophy in any way?

DAW: I was into Asian antiques, vintage cars, watches, and furniture and of course into books, music, films and wines. It was all about surrounding myself and enjoying the most beautiful things of what life has to offer.

PHILLIPS: From your point of view, what are the key trends shaping the future of art collecting and collection management? Which part of the technological advances today excites you the most?

DAW: Collecting art (like many other categories) has become a lot easier and transparent with the birth of the internet. With the birth of blockchain technology in 2009, art collecting and collection management will move more digital. This does not mean that physical and traditional art media will disappear, but it will be more and more digitally depicted. Blockchain and NFTs are a game changer for traditional and digital art. The last two years of the Covid19 pandemic have perpetuated this shift.





American artist Nikki is an emerging talent in the world of contemporary art, celebrated for her colourful and uplifting artworks that aim to capture the joyful experiences of her childhood memories in America and Germany.

Calling to mind the work of renowned Japanese artist Yoshitomo Nara, the subject of Nikki's artwork is a large headed, youthful girl who although is endearing, has a mischievous streak too. However, lie at the core of Nikki's practice is utilization of both spray paint and airbrush techniques, and the rendering of a digital and pixilated look to her character. The artist address through her creations to a society that has achieved an unprecedented level of digitalization. The surface of her painting is almost mechanically flat, evoking the luminosity of a digital screen as viewers' imagination animates beyond the physical world.



Growing up in New York City in the '80s and '90s has shaped American visual artist Jerkface's conceptual mindset and vision. Through his artistic practice, he experiences vicariously and reimagines the tiny, insular yet prospective downtown world of Avant-garde artists such as Andy Warhol and Jean-Michel Basquiat. The streets, be it harsh or pleasant, have always been his playground and his great escape.

"Almost all my compositions reflect something that relates to my childhood. If I can't relate to it, the creative process isn't enjoyable, and the work suffers." — Jerkface

The iconic reputative composition of the present lot, *Dr Seuss' Cat in the Hat*, like most of the artist's paintings, was inspired by vivid Pop Art palette and bright, unbridled 'Memphis' design style. The canvas is fully occupied by cartoon figures rendered with clean and dynamic geometric abstractions of reds and whites. A classic example of Jerkface's oeuvre, and as the title suggests, this work depicts the cat protagonist in one of his childhood favourites – *The Cat in the Hat*. The magical, witty, and entertaining cat brings to the audience what he calls "fun that is funny", which resonates with the artist's approach as he creates works that delight and captivate the global contemporary art scene.

Born in 1982, Jerkface now lives and works in New York City. The artist was introduced to Asia with his first solo exhibition, *Saturday Morning*, which turned out to be a sell-out success, at Over the Influence Gallery, Hong Kong (20 October - 10 December 2016). Marion Peck is an American female painter who is one of the leading figures in Pop Surrealism Art movement. Inspired by her time studying and living in Rome, Peck makes clear reference to Italian Renaissance painting techniques, scene settings and colour palettes in her fanciful yet mysteriously dark Surrealist narratives. The fusion of the two seemingly distant painting styles collides into an instantly recognizable visual presence that garners Peck a growing following worldwide.

Peck's subject matter covers religious scene, still life, classical portraitures of both modern humans dressed in historical costumes and everyday figures, such as what is depicted in the current work *Business Man*. Having his lustrous chestnut hair neatly brushed back, the figure is depicted in a grey woollen suit, with a blue-and-red checkered tie matching his beige shirt. His eyes glow with kindness, yet the absurdity of his appearance is hard to look over: his right eye depicted here is of a distorted angle, with a nose grows out of his half-rendered nose underneath, revealing a rather unusual way of looking at a person. This work is a prime example of Peck's distinct and skilful way of challenging viewers' perceptions by evoking an alien and uneasy feeling towards an otherwise ordinary subject through distorted perceptual depictions.

The evolvement of Peck's artistic style is inseparable with her renowned artist husband, Mark Ryden. 

Jade Kim is a South Korean visual artist working in the medium of painting and sculpture. Having worked in the fields of exhibition curation and product planning for nearly a decade, Kim eventually chose to pursue his passion and became an artist.

Drawing on inspiration from his endearment for his wife, Kim created his signature character 'Min', who shares similar personalities, hobbies, social issues and so on with his beloved wife. With big, wide eyes, and child-like appearance, Min is often depicted amidst mesmerizing, otherworldly background of nature or starry night sky, appearing sometimes melancholic and concerning, at other times serene and etheric. Through incorporating celestial elements into his work, the artist conveys a deep sense of care and love that he has for the world and the planet that we reside on.

The present lot, *Reflection*, focus in on the theme of different sides of a person. The work depicts the gloomy Min floats amidst the deep blue that fittingly echoes her mood, while holding hands with her silver-haired alter ego. This other Min hovers over a passionately vibrate red background that by contrast, reflects her sense of withdrawal from the mundane world, and thus bringing into focus the humane concern that projects out of brown-haired Min's clear, ocean blue eyes.

The two Mins represent two sides of the character, with a split down the centre of the picture that divides the blue and red, visually creating a sense of separation of the two figures. The angle of the idea of reflection leads to the notion of separation of a whole. Yet Kim remedies this division by joining the two figures together, juxtaposing the dichotomy of split and union of the same individual while exuding much love and harmony onto the canvas.

Born in 1981 in Seoul, South Korea, Kim studied at the Korea National University of Arts, and now lives and works in his hometown. Kim's latest group shows include *The Flow* held at Fir Gallery, Beijing (26 March - 5 May 2022), and *New Wave* at JN Gallery, Seoul (26 August - 24 September 2022). His first ever solo exhibition, *The Blooming Moment*, with the Warehouse Gallery and Gallery Func in Shanghai (29 July - 29 August 2022), coincides with his debut in mainland China.
