

Olivia Thornton, Phillips' Head of Modern & Contemporary Art, Europe, said, "We are thrilled with the result of £12.8 million. The standout highlight was our 100%-sold group of works by Christo & Jeanne-Claude, which spoke to collectors worldwide and achieved 188% above the low estimate on the 90th anniversary year of the artists' births. Our top lot was Jean-Michel Basquiat's *MP*, which realised nearly £4.9 million, underscoring the global appetite for Basquiat's raw energy and Phillips' strength in his market. After a spirited seven-minute bidding war, Martha Jungwirth's *Ohne Titel* sold for six times its low estimate. With 90% of lots fresh to market or unseen at auction in the last 20 years, we assembled a compelling international sale that resonated with collectors from 53 countries, reinforcing London's status as Europe's centre for Modern & Contemporary art."
