Contemporary editions from the 1970s and 80s led the auction with two works by Keith Haring and five works by Andy Warhol featuring prominently in the top ten lots. Following the Queen's jubilee celebrations last week Warhol's *Queen Elizabeth II* very fittingly brought in the top price in the auction, selling for £352,800, over three times the estimate. Ahead of our dedicated David Hockney auction in September we were also thrilled to sell all Hockney works above their high estimates, setting a new auction record for *Untitled No. 1, from The Yosemite Suite*, proving that now really is the time to sell Hockney! It has been a remarkable season since we expanded our global editions calendar of sales and we look forward to the Summer Editions auction finale which will take place on 25 June in Southampton, New York."
