Phillips' New York Evening Sale Realizes \$155 Million, the Second Highest Sale Total in Company History

Gerhard Richter's Abstraktes Bild (636) Leads Auction at \$35 Million

Robert Manley, Deputy Chairman and Worldwide Co-Head of 20th Century & Contemporary Art, said, "At \$155 million, tonight's auction marks the second highest sale total in Phillips' history. Leading the sale was Gerhard Richter's monumental *Abstraktes Bild (636)*, commanding nearly \$35 million and firmly placing it among the top five works ever offered by the artist. We were pleased to set a new world record for Jadé Fadojutimi with her *Quirk my mannerism* realizing over \$1.9 million, tripling the low estimate. The inclusion of The Triton Collection Foundation's works alongside those from our various owner sale added a distinctive dimension to the evening. This fusion contributed to the vibrant tapestry of artistic narratives that define Phillips and our commitment to presenting diverse and compelling sales."

We showcased a group of century-spanning, movement-defining works that were completely fresh-to-the market. We saw an enthusiastic response across the board, from the Nabis to the Cubist masters. Leading the group was Fernand Léger's *Le 14 juillet*, which featured a recently discovered painting on the verso, hidden until the Foundation unearthed the work last year. This discovery exemplifies how the Foundation sets the gold standard for passion and commitment to their mission, ensuring the continued preservation of the avant-garde spirit for generations to come."
